- Compare and contrast current DSM criteria with the proposed changes in DSM-5.

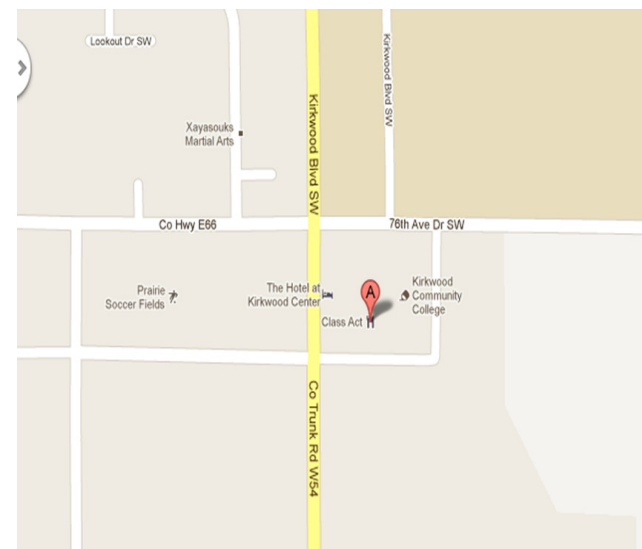
